Minutes from last meeting

AGM – As agreed at the last AGM the minutes for the AGM were approved in principle via email following the meeting. They will be formally ratified at the 2015 AGM.

Matters Arising:

- Discussed wording to back up the agreement of affiliation to NSN that is made when school teams register with NSN. Proposed that schools should seek a similar commitment from parents /guardians in their registration forms for students. (Or if this has already been completed for 2015 by email when the student's team is confirmed.)

Proposed wording (based on the wording on the NSN rep nomination forms) is:

“By submitting this registration form, you are automatically declaring that the information enclosed is correct and your child or ward shall be subject to all rules, regulations of the Northern Suburbs Netball and expectations in accordance with the Northern Suburbs Netball code of conduct.”

Motion passed unanimously.

Draw committee update -update from Lena, Yvonne and Darlene

No update as yet. Will meet and get registration forms onto website. Registrations will open 20 March and remain open for 2 weeks so will close 2 April.

Junior netball Update-update from Ann and Kelly

Ran the year 3 pilot last year and it worked well. 28 students attended.

This year look at running the year 3s season in 2nd term.

Plan is to run the year 3s on Saturdays after competition finishes (around 2pm start) for a term block.

Parents will register individual children not the school. Schools should encourage parents to be involved because the intention is to growing coaches as well.

Will be likely to limit numbers – this may be limited to number per school. There will be a similar registration period as for the year 4 to 8s i.e. open 20 March in by 2nd April which gives Ann 3 weeks (2 of holiday) to sort out.

Schools should probably give their students a heads up that coming (and maybe gauge interest /how many will be likely to register) but wait for information to come out from Ann before any further details are provided to parents.

Years 1& 2 will be trickier.

Some of the ideas considered would be to run it in smaller hubs; on Saturdays in term 3; register as individuals (boys and girls) no school uniforms not school teams.

Ann will discuss with the junior netball sub-committee and then send something out. The subcommittee hopes to meet in the next week.

Will also need to plan for first aid officer, toilet facilities.

Year 4s will play as normal with junior rules this year – but next year will move onto the new Netball NZ system and play those rules. Skills session + modified games 2/3 court, with lower posts.

Registrations for rep trials close 12 April.

Coaches will become selectors but if conflict of interest (such as child or relation trialling) independent selectors will be involved. It was agreed that NSN should police check coaches and managers – this requirement will be included in application forms.

An indoor training venue has been booked for reps on Wednesdays at Karori Rep centre. First training is 3rd May. The year 7s will train from 7pm to 8pm and the year 8s from 8pm to 9pm. There will also be Sunday training from 10am to noon, starting 17 May.

Uniforms will be issued on 17 May.

The committee had a discussion about the number of tournaments, training sessions and the impact on growing children's bodies. Kelly will try and source a medical view from High Performance Sport physiotherapists as to what is appropriate and then seek input from schools (delegates to ensure they obtain their schools view).

Given the 2015 season Rep handbook provides for 4-6 tournaments and the levies are set at the AGM \$185 based on the number of tournaments it was felt that the cost can't be changed this year so to aim for 4 tournaments. A subcommittee (Chris, Kate and Louise) will look at what tournaments are appropriate.

A fundraising pub quiz night on the 24th May has been booked at 1841 in Johnsonville. The quiz master is included for the price. All profit will be for the reps.

If the tickets are set at \$15 per person for ticket this will generate more than \$1k profit. The reps will be pre-warned about the expectation on them to sell the tickets. The tickets will need to be sold by 20 May (and money back to Chris before then).
