Minutes from last meeting

Minutes from 18 March 2015 accepted without amendment.

Draw committee update -update from Lena, Yvonne and Darlene

Registrations closed 2 April. 19 schools and 98 teams registered – 40 in intermediate, 17 year 4 teams, 16 year 5 teams and 25 year 6 teams.

For grading games we've moved Thorndon White from year 5 to year 4 and Rewa Rewa from year 6 to year 5 - these teams are predominantly younger and it gave us even numbers of teams in each grade so that everyone

would play (and no byes).

To fit all the games in the first 3 rounds at the college & the first round at NIS will all be year 7/8 games. All intermediate finished by 11am.

Then essentially courts 1-4 will play year 6, courts 5 & 6 will play year 5 teams and year 4 will play at NIS (with 1 year 5 game).

Unfortunately we need 1 more round than last year for only 1 game on lower hoops. This game will be courts 5/6 at the College.

Draw will be up Tuesday (Monday holiday). School invoices out by end of next week (Friday 1/2 May).

Discussed set up of the registration system – schools can't go back in to fix /update.

Queried whether it is possible to have:

- feature that allows schools to enter multiple times before submitted finally; and
- a Dropbox feature

The Draw Committee asked that registrations not be submitted with just a name in, as this then requires the Draw Committee to input the data.

Registrations have closed for the ANZ FF Year 3 programme – 59 registered. Sessions will be held Saturday 2 May – Saturday 4 July (no play 30 May) at 1.45-2.45 and 2.45-3.45pm at the Intermediate.

Need to look into basic first aid supplies - are these available in the shed – or do we need to get new supply.

Need to see if we can get access to Newlands Intermediate for toilets.

Have run a coaching course (10 attended) for parents – and am trying to tap into coaching courses run for the other satellites for other coaches who could not make the Monday night. Waiting to hear back from Netball Wellington.

General Business

- Papurangi requested that Year 3s be allowed to play for year 4 team. The Exec committee discussed and agreed that Papurangi year 3s could be included in a year 4 team. The school rep and draw Committee were informed.
- BBQ roster – Kate sent out BBQ roster and guidelines to teams who had registered interest (for one or two dates). BBQ roster on website. Gaps 20 June, 1 August, 8 August, 15 August, 29 August + rain day. Contact Kate if you are want to fill the dates.
The idea of lowering the cost of hiring the BBQ (from ?\$65) was raised. This needs to be considered at AGM and will be added to the agenda.
- Umpire Books – some were available at the meeting and will be available from First Aider on Saturdays at cost of \$7.
- Adults umpiring session at 1pm after rep trials at the college - 12 adults registered by due date. Khandallah, Ngaio and Cashmere and Crofton Downs offered year 5/6 teams for practice. Any late adults can attend but observe only as too tough for children to play more games.
- 2015 intermediate bell times available on the website now.
- Uniforms: confirmed what current are. Photos of the registered playing uniforms are available on the website. Clothes worn underneath the uniform such as thermals/ compression tops and leggings must be as registered and recorded on the website or not worn at all. It is up to umpires to police compliance but team managers must also take responsibility to ensure that undue pressure is not put on student umpires to enforce.

- Uniform for Amesbury. Changing t-shirts but not for next 5 or so weeks. Can change mid-season if registered (Amesbury to send photo of new uniform). All team will wear same uniform.

Up to all team managers and umpires to ensure that players are in the correct registered uniform, as recorded on the website or advised by school delegate. Up to all spectators to ensure appropriate behaviour both on the side-lines and on the courts. If you have concerns raise with the Duty Umpire if assistance needed. No dogs to netball courts please.
