

BBQ Information Guide 2015.

Background

During the winter netball competition NSN provide a BBQ which is available for hire. All participating member schools are eligible to hire and 'run' the BBQ as a fundraiser for their school. Notification will be sent to your school via your school delegate who represents your school on the committee.

Guidance

The hirer is responsible for providing ALL hire fees, equipment, supplies etc. at their cost

Team : you will need a minimum of three people to run a stress and hassle free BBQ !

Location: the BBQ is operated next to the gymnasium at Newlands College, beside the coffee cart, near the netball courts.

Set up: The BBQ is stored in the NSN shed which is located on the side of the Newlands gym, ask a committee member for directions. Committee members wear high visibility tops. Set up the BBQ and folding table at 8.00am. You'll need to cook 60 -80 sausages so that they are available for sale during the first round which commences at 8.30am.

Float money: Please provide your own cash container and float for change.

BBQ Hire: The hire fee is \$65 (BBQ & gas) payable to NSN, collected on the day.

Supplies

The following are suggested quantities of the supplies required, based on a typical Saturday morning. (March 2014 prices are from Prestons in Porirua – phone 237 7313)

Sausages: 4 bags pre-cooked (75 per bag). Preston's price – approx. \$25.00 per bag.

Bread: 10 x white sandwich loaves. \$1.60 per loaf

Onions: 3 bags (1kg) - pre-cut. Preston's price - \$5.80 per bag.

Sauce: Tomato sauce 2 x 2L and 'squirt bottles'. American mustard (large) x 2 or 3.

Serviettes: 300



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Don't Forget - Other 'must haves' for the day;

BBQ Implements: Tongs, turning slices, scissors, knife.

Miscellaneous: Oil, disposable gloves, paper towels, tin foil, large oven dishes to hold cooked sausages. Container for holding cooked onions.

Options

Some schools also provide other items for sale as part of the BBQ, such as 'home baking' and soft drinks (suggested quantity of 30 units for the drinks).

Packing Up

The final round is played at 12.20pm and the shed is locked at 1pm. Please ensure the BBQ and folding table are cleaned and put away in the shed by 12.30pm. The BBQ must be cleaned and all rubbish taken home with you.

You will need to bring cleaner (spray and wipe recommended), bucket, cloths, rubbish bags.
